

Although our international mission trips were cancelled in 2020 due to Covid-19, that didn't stop us from making a difference. It would be impossible for us to share about every international endeavor around the world that we're involved in, but here are a few that we know would make you smile!

01: Africa



Needs met.

Through our partnership with MasterCares Africa, we fed over 200 local families through the Feeding Program in the country of Uganda.

02: Dominican Republic



Care provided.

Through our partnership with One Child Matters, our giving helped provide food and care to 8,000 unsponsored children enrolled in the program.

03: India



The hungry fed.


Through our partnership with Carmel Community Church, food distributions were held in the slums of Delhi to support hundreds of slum families during the pandemic.

Some additional missional highlights...

- HC provided care packages to hospital staff in 6 departments at 2 different hospitals.
- HC restored a local historical African American cemetery.
- HC provided aid to dozens of single mothers through Embrace Grace.
- Along with a partnership of churches, we gave away 10 million meals through Convoy of Hope in 2020.
- We supplied 4 loads of disaster relief supplies and equipment to the hurricanes in Jackson, Mississippi.
- HC sowed over \$14,000 in partnership with 5 different organizations in Israel.
- HC helped plant 35 in-person churches and 22 online churches in 2020. Those 57 churches had an average attendance of 336 people and 522 total decisions for Christ.
- HC provided Christmas gifts for over 200 children at New Covenant Church (Sri Lanka)
- HC translated pastoral resources into Farsi for hundreds of church leaders in the nation of Iran.
- HC began *Shepherd's Rest*. A program led by Pastor Dan Dean designed to refresh, mentor, train and build pastors in ministry.
- HC provided 500 gifts to children around the world through our partnership with Samaritan's Purse.
- HC provided 185 meals to Thanksgiving meals to families in need in our community.
